Therapy Assistant Responsibilities:

- To independently carry out communication and eating and drinking support to students as directed by the qualified Speech and Language therapist.
- To independently undertake observations across different settings within the colleges learning environments as directed by the qualified Speech and Language Therapist.
- To participate in the assessment process alongside the qualified Speech and Language Therapist.
- Deliver training to the staff team (total communication, eating and drinking etc) as directed by the Speech and Language Therapist
- To write communication plans alongside the Speech and Language Therapist
- To deliver group and 1-1 therapy sessions under the guidance of the Speech and Language Therapist.
- To liaise with external Speech Therapy Teams to support the use of AAC devices within the college and ensure devices are updated as required.
- To independently work on therapy-based projects working across multidisciplines where required.
- To work collaboratively across the multi-disciplinary therapy team and wider curriculum team to promote effective total communication for all.
- To maintain up to date records and reporting in line with the company's current electronic recording system.
- To attend EHCP reviews and weekly therapy Multi Disciplinary Team meetings to provide accurate reports and oversights of input and individual student progress.

- To work autonomously across all fields but know where they must take guidance from qualified therapists.
- To understand the risk factors associated with the client group and to respond and report any concerns in line with the company policy and procedures.
- To support students during times of emotional distress, seeking the support of others where required.
- To travel to all sites including campuses in Sileby, Mountsorrel and Nuneaton.
- Maintain own professional development and seek out regular training opportunities.
- Attend regular clinical supervision utilising a reflective practice approach.
